PICK UP

- Containers must be placed out for service no later than 5:00am on the day of collection. Both cans will be picked up every week and lids must close completely for proper pick up. Do not overfill containers.
- Cans should be placed on the street surface (not on the sidewalk) and away from vehicles. Cans should be placed so that the lid opening faces the street or alley.
- Gilton does not pick up on New Year's Day, 4th of July, Thanksgiving or Christmas Day. If your normal collection day falls on one of these holidays, your collection day will fall one day later that week.

ADDITIONAL GARBAGE PROGRAMS

- **Free Collection of E-Waste**— Four appointments per customer per year.
- **Free Collection of Bulky Items**— Twice a year for large bulky items such as refrigerators, furniture and appliances.
- **Free CRT Disposal**— Two vouchers per year. (Televisions or Computer Monitors)

BILLING HIGHLIGHTS

Utilities are Billed Bimonthly:

- 1st of odd month –bills are mailed
- 1st of even month –bills are due

Payment Types Accepted:

- Cash, Check, and Money Orders are accepted at City Hall
- Credit Cards are accepted **online only** and a \$4.50 fee is charged.

Water Termination:

Water service will be disconnected for non-payment. A \$39 fee will apply. See the attached Utility Calendar for a schedule of billing, payment and termination dates.

Unauthorized Turn-On:

Residents will be charged an additional \$39 fee for turning on water that has been disconnected by the City.

Visit www.cityofescalon.org and click on the Residents page for more information.

Closing Accounts:

You must notify the City when you move.

Changes to Account:

Signature is required to make any changes on your account.

Senior/Disabled Rates:

Garbage discount available to residents at least 65 years of age or permanently disabled. Rate is not automatic or retroactive. The form is available at City Hall.

CITY OF ESCALON SERVICES

WATER

The City of Escalon is on metered water. You will have two types of water charges on your bill. Water Base Charge* is a flat rate charge and consumed water is based on tiered pricing. Your rates can be found on the back of your bill or all rates can be found on our website at www.cityofescalon.org.

SEWER

Residents connected to the City sewer will see one of the following FLAT RATE charges on the bill: Residential detached (single family homes) - \$48.86 per bill
Residential attached (duplexes, triplexes, multi-family homes) - \$36.43 per bill. All rates can be found on our website at www.cityofescalon.org.

GARBAGE

Garbage and Green Waste service is mandatory for residents. Gilton holds the current contract for garbage service and rates are as follows:

Rates will increase annually on Aug. 15th

- 60 gallon Garbage Can - \$24.72 per bill
- 60 gallon - Senior Rate - \$20.72 per bill
- 90 gallon Garbage Can - \$31.70 per bill
- 90 gallon - Senior Rate - \$27.70 per bill
- Green Waste Can - \$10.78 per bill
- Each Additional Can - \$ 6.22 per bill

Front Loader Bins and Roll Off Boxes are available directly from Gilton Solid Waste.
