



RTD | Mobility OFFERS: Travel Training General Public (GP) Dial-A-Ride

- Live in the City of Stockton or in the rural areas of San Joaquin County?
- Need to get groceries or go to medical appointments, or simply want to get out more?
- Need to go to an interview for an employment opportunity?

RTD Mobility administers grant-funded programs designed to connect senior citizens, low-income residents, and people with disabilities with the full range of San Joaquin RTD services. RTD offers travel training services for those individuals residing in the City of Stockton and in the rural areas of San Joaquin County who are not familiar with RTD's services.

Travel Training:

- Teaches individuals how to use RTD's bus services
- Offers trainees one-on-one instruction on how to use public transportation
- Increases confidence and independence
- Provides transportation freedom

General Public (GP) Dial-A-Ride:

- Is curb-to-curb service in areas not currently being served by RTD or other local transportation providers
- Connects people from rural San Joaquin County to Stockton and surrounding cities
- Is open to the general public with no application necessary for use
- Costs \$3.00 per one-way ride
- Operates: Monday-Friday 5:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. and on weekends and holidays 7:15 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Requires reservations 1-7 days in advance. To schedule a ride, call (209) 955-8400
