



GARBAGE SERVICE

BLACK CAN

- Household garbage and trash
- Pet Waste

PICK UP

- Containers must be placed out for service no later than 5:00am on the day of collection. Both cans will be picked up every week and lids must close completely for proper pick up. Do not overfill containers.
- Cans should be placed on the street surface (not on the sidewalk) and away from vehicles. Cans should be placed so that the lid opening faces the street or alley.
- Gilton does not pick up on New Year's Day, 4th of July, Thanksgiving or Christmas Day. If your normal collection day falls on or after one of these holidays, your collection day will fall one day later that week.

ADDITIONAL GARBAGE PROGRAMS

- Free Collection of E-Waste**— Four ap-pointments per customer per year.
- Free Collection of Bulky Items**— Twice a year for large bulky items such as refriger-ators, furniture and appliances. All items must fit within a 6' x 6' x 6' area. See our website for specifics on what is and is not acceptable.
- Free CRT Disposal**— Two vouchers per year. (Televisions or Computer Monitors)

BILLING HIGHLIGHTS

Utilities are Billed Bimonthly:

- Bills are mailed on 1st of odd month
- Bills are due 7 days after issuance

Payment Types Accepted:

- Cash, Check, Credit Cards and Money Orders are accepted at City Hall.
- Credit Cards are also accepted online and by phone.
- Sign up for Automatic Payments. Form available at City Hall or on the website.

Water Termination:

Water service will be disconnected for non-payment and a \$40 fee will apply. See the Utility Calendar including a schedule of billing, payment due dates and termination dates. Go to <https://tinyurl.com/escwaterdisc> for more information.

Unauthorized Turn-On:

Residents will be charged an additional \$35 fee for turning on water that has been disconnected by the City.

Visit www.cityofescalon.org and click on the Utility Billing page for information.

Closing Accounts:

To close an account, please fill out a Cancel Service form. You can fill out the form online at www.cityofescalon.org or pick one up at City Hall.

Changes to Account:

Fill out and turn in a service change form. Changes can also be submitted on our website.

Senior/Disabled Rates:

Garbage discount available to residents 67 years of age or permanently disabled, for 60-gal can only. Rate is not automatic or retroactive. The form is available at City Hall.

CITY OF ESCALON SERVICES

WATER

The City of Escalon is on metered water. You will have two types of water charges on your bill: Water (based on usage) and Base Charge (flat rate charge). All rates can be found on the utility billing page of the City website at www.cityofescalon.org.

SEWER

Residents connected to the City sewer will see one of the following flat rate charges on the bill: Residential Detached (single family homes) or Residential

Attached (duplexes, triplexes, multi-family homes). All rates can be found on the utility billing page of the website at www.cityofescalon.org.

GARBAGE

Garbage and Green Waste service is mandatory for all residents. Gilton Solid Waste holds the current contract for garbage service and rates are as follows:

- 60 gallon Garbage Can - \$32.58 per bill
- 60 gallon - Senior Rate - \$26.58 per bill
- 90 gallon Garbage Can - \$40.00 per bill
- Green Waste Can - \$28.60 per bill
- Each Additional Can - \$18.90 per bill

Front loader bins and roll off boxes are available directly from Gilton Solid Waste.
